

## 56th Annual Meeting - Atlanta, Georgia, USA

The 2025 DDA meeting will take place May 19-23 in Atlanta, GA, on the campus of [Georgia Institute of Technology](#) [1]



We will have a five-day format that incorporates a hybrid approach with a robust attendance experience for both in-person and remote attendees. Additionally, it is a priority for us to continue improving the experience for poster presenters, both in-person and remote.

The conference will host the oral and poster sessions, as well as the public lecture, in the [Exhibition Hall](#) [2] ([map](#) [3]).

A banquet will be held at the [Georgia Tech Hotel & Conference Center](#) [4], and a pre-conference reception will take place at the [Student Success Center](#) [5].
